What can I do if the WebService of MPS 203 I4.0 is not available via web browser?

Solution (public)

To test if the port 80 is blocked by Windows, please do the following procedure:

- Press the "Windows" button on your keyboard;
- type in "cmd", right mousebutton "Open as administrator";
- Type in: "net stop HTTP".

Then start the WebService again and test if the site is available:

If that worked, you can stop the http-service permanently by browsing the registry:

- Start RegEdit (Windows Key, then type in "regedit", enter.
- Browse to HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\SYSTEM\CurrentControlSet\Services\HTTP;
- Change the value of start "start" to 4 to deactivate the service;
- Restart the PC.
